- » Denver, Colorado has plans to recycle materials from 11 scheduled re-roofing projects.
- » Insulation and EPDM membranes must be recycled on all re-roofing projects taking place on state-owned buildings in Wisconsin.
- » Over 53,000 pounds of EPDM recycled in Troy, MI in one year.
- » Over 1,500 cubic yards of expanded polystyrene insulation and 48,000 pounds of EPDM recycled in Missouri in one year.
